The basis of ever more growing animal husbandry is that it relies not only on the domestic cultivation of feed, but also on immense amounts of imported feed, in which protein, such as soya in particular, play a large role. Most fodder components could also serve directly as human foodstuffs.

The high meat consumption in the rich industrial nations, led by the USA and Germany, contribute quite specifically to hunger in the world by using these basic foodstuffs as feed, also by the use of cultivation areas for the imported feed.
